CONDITIONS COVERING PURCHASE AND OPENING OF GRAVES

1 PURCHASED GRAVES LAWN SECTIONS

- (a) The exclusive Rights of Burial shall be granted for a period of 75 years.
- (b) An area of 1050 mm (3'6") long measured from the head of the grave space is permitted for a headstone and/or flowers. The remaining area of the Grave Space will be turfed over and kept mown by the Cemetery staff.
- (c) A Memorial not exceeding 900 mm (3ft) in height (including base) above ground level 750 mm (2'6") in width and not be less than 75mm (3") or more than 300 mm (1ft thick) may be placed at head of grave subject to permission being granted and all fees paid.
- (d) Glassware, jam jars or other receptacles which, in the opinion of the Cemetery Manager, are considered to be dangerous or unsightly will be removed.
