The open space known as the Vine has a long history.

The earliest known reporting of cricket in Sevenoaks is a report in the London Evening Post of a match between the Gentlemen of Kent and Sussex, which took place on 6th September 1734. Lord John Philip Sackville of Knole pitted his team and his purse against the Gentlemen of Sussex. In 1773. John Frederick Sackville. the 3rd Duke of Dorset presented the Vine Ground out of the Knole Estate to the town of Sevenoaks to be a cricket ground forever. In 1777, the 18th June saw the introduction of the third stump on The Vine. In 1850 the Pavilion was built, now a Grade II listed building. In 1894 the Bandstand was built. The former Practice

Room was recently turned into the Café on the Vine.

Seven oak trees were planted here to commemorate the coronation of King Edward VII in 1902 and six had to be replaced after the hurricane of 1987.

The actual name of The Vine is a mystery, but possibly relates to the existence of a vineyard near the Ground in the 14th Century when the Knole estates were owned by the Archbishop of Canterbury. Sevenoaks Town Council took over the management of the Vine Cricket Ground and Vine Gardens on its formation in 1974.

The Vine won Gold and Best in Class in South and South East In Bloom 2024 and has Green Flag status. It is part of the town's entry for Britain In Bloom 2025.

Join us for a summer of events on the Vine






