Cafe on the Vine

Hollybush Recreation Ground

Hollybush Recreation Ground is one of the assets requested for transfer from Sevenoaks District Council to Sevenoaks Town Council, the request was turned down by the District Council due to projected income and being of strategic importance for the development of the depot in Otford Road. The Town Council is hoping to have the opportunity to appeal this decision.

In an effort to protect Hollybush Recreation Ground from any future development pressure or loss of community access, Sevenoaks Town Council has submitted the application to nominate the area as an 'Asset of Community Value'.

The Town Council's Planning & Environment Committee agreed that the nomination should also include the informal recreation field within the site, as well as the two steeper fields to the south of the Recreation Ground, which are often used for walking and community access to Knole Park. Sevenoaks Town Council is eager to retain opportunities for free outside recreation and keep these areas available for the community to use.

Complete our survey about the future of local community assets

The government's plans for Local Government Reorganisation are moving forward as the government says, 'At Pace'. Sevenoaks Town Council are not involved in the future of Kent County Council or Sevenoaks District Council, this is for them to agree plans with the government. However, the Town Council is very concerned about the future of local community assets which makes living, working and visiting Sevenoaks the town it is.

The Town Council already operates many community facilities but there are some which belong to Sevenoaks District Council and the concern is that when the district council ceases to exist these assets will automatically move to a new Unitary Authority who will be a considerable distance away and is likely to be overwhelmed with social care responsibilities and unable to have the capacity to worry about local parks or markets etc. in Sevenoaks.

Planning

This week, Town Councillors were consulted on nine planning applications, an unusually low number.

Town Councillors agreed to support local residents and recommend to Sevenoaks District Council that the planning application for the demolition of the Greensands Care Home and construction of eight flats be refused on the grounds of Overlooking of Neighbouring Properties, Inappropriate Bulk and Massing of the Site, the Designs are incongruent with the Residential Character Area Assessment, Concerns over protection of TPO trees and Concerns about Biodiversity Net Gain calculations.

Town Councillors were also pleased to note that following lobbying about the previous Royal Oak Hotel development, it is now expected to retain reference to its name and be called 'The Old Royal Oak'.
