Greatness Recreation Ground – Football & Community Pavilion

I am delighted that we have been able to publicise the success of the Football Foundation (£759,100) and Stadium (£150,000) grants towards the new Greatness Recreation Ground – Football & Community Pavilion.

Between Sevenoaks Town Football Club and Sevenoaks Town Council, just under £2m external funding has been obtained for this project. Funding is now secured to commence this. Budget restrictions has required some 'value engineering' (reduction in specification). The project now covers the construction of the shell of the building. Further fundraising will be ongoing for the fit out, car park and landscaping.

All going well, we are trying to sort out legal, administrative and contract matters to commence September/October 2025.



Britain in Bloom judging and help needed
