Youth Council Elections 2016 – An update

- 1) Sevenoaks Youth Council's Annual General Meeting [AGM]
The AGM is now set for Wednesday 12th October 2016.

Revised Sevenoaks Youth Council Election leaflets have been printed.

Kent County Council [KCC] Youth Participation team are holding the Local Democracy Week during the week of 10th to 16th October 2016.

Kent County Council confirmed on 21.06.2016 that the Kent Youth County Council elections will be held from 7th – 20th November 2016. A change since the last meeting of Sevenoaks Youth Council on 08.06.2016.

- 2) Elections

Sevenoaks Youth Council

- has now teamed up with Walthamstow Hall School who will send representatives and are asking their pupils to apply to become Youth Councillors
- is continuing working with Knole Academy and is teamed up with them also to send representatives and asking pupils to apply to become Youth Councillors
- has liaised with Trinity School who will meet to discuss partnerships in September
- has liaised with Weald of Kent Grammar School and will meet first week in September to discuss representatives, possibly with an attendance in their PHSE lesson early September 2016 – date to be confirmed.

It is proposed that each school would send some representatives to each meeting with there being one vote per school. Terms of Reference would be updated at the AGM.

Bonnie from STC has recently donated a Guitar and stand which I’m sure will be useful.

KCC Funding has again been delayed, at present we have the funding until 30th November 2016. Sarah Gaunt, Youth Hub Delivery Manager, reported to the recent Sevenoaks District Town & Parish forum that:

KCC currently commissions 3 providers to deliver 4 contracts in the district of Sevenoaks. These contracts were due to come to an end on 30th June with a new commissioned provider starting on the 1st July. This isn’t happening just yet. Current contracts have been extended to 30th November with the new commissioned provider starting on 1st December. 2 bids were submitted for the contract for Sevenoaks District. They have been evaluated and pre-contract meetings have been arranged with those who submitted the bids and with Sevenoaks District Council. When all of this has been completed an announcement will be made saying who has been awarded the contract for Sevenoaks District.
