3-4 years and 5-6 years students attend a 90 minute class with a specialist performing arts teacher who delivers 30 minutes of each, dance, drama and singing. 7 – 18 years students are divided into appropriate age groups and attended an hour of dance an hour of drama and an hour of singing with subject specialist. The year is divided into three exciting terms, following the school year: Technique Term – developing skills and building confidence Presentation Term – preparing and refining performance skills Show Term – bringing everything together for an exciting end-of-year show Fees Each full term at Jigsaw Arts costs £176.
